
WHEREAS, during that time he has successfully elevated the prestige of our Chamber of Commerce and developed it into an organization worthy of leadership in our Capital City, and

WHEREAS, he has set forth farsighted plans for the development of our business and industry and expanded the surrounding area during his tenure as General Manager, and


