

# Resolution of Award No. 2733

**Resolved**, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 11th day of March 19 49, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **MERWIN & GATEJEN**

at the prices specified in **their** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the ~~installation~~ **installation of an Electrolier System complete in Sutter Way from the westerly boundary of Merkley Tract (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), produced Southerly to the Easterly Boundary of Swanston Palms Unit No. 3 (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), produced Northerly; San Luis Court from a line joining the Northerly line of Lot 5 and 16 of said Swanston Palms Unit No. 3 to the Southerly line of Sutter Way; Muir Way from a line joining the Northerly line of Lots 38 and 78 of said Swanston Palms Unit No. 3**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2733, passed and adopted by said City Council on January 28th 19 49, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the **Sacramento Union** a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
