AMENDING VACATION RULE

Pursuant to action of the Board

June 6, 1946, Mr. Root moved that

Rule 2, Section 1, "General Provisions

Relating to Vacations" be amended to read as follows:

RULE 2 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1 - Vacations:

After one year of continuous service, each employee of the City of Sacramento is entitled to fifteen days of vacation with pay, excluding time during which he is not regularly assigned to work. For the purpose of computing vacation time, each employee shall be considered to work not more than five days each week.

Upon the approval of the Department Head, employees may take their vacation allowance in periods of not less than one week.

Seconded by Mr. Deise, motion carried.
