

Resolution of Award No. 2547

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 21st day of June 19 46, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **A. Teichert & Son, Inc.**

at the prices specified in **their** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of
Streets, Ways, Avenues and Alleys within and adjacent to East Sacramento Terrace and East Sacramento Terrace Unit No. 2, and F Street from the northerly projection of the Westerly boundary of Monterey Terrace to the southerly projection of the centerline of Elvas Avenue

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2547, passed and adopted by said City Council on May 17 1946, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the Sacramento Union a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
