**SUBJECT: Replacement of Animal Control Center, Phase I (PN:GA06) - Resolution  
Approving Negative Declaration**

**SUMMARY**

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

**BACKGROUND**

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the Replacement of Animal Control Center, Phase I project would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On June 28, 1989, the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On July 1, 1989, Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

The existing Animal Control Center was constructed in 1938, encompasses 6,200 square feet and kennels approximately 60 animals per day. The facility is now inadequate, both for kennel and office space, because the current demand for kenneling is approximately 200 animals per day and the office staff has tripled over the years. The new facility is expected to meet the needs of the City for the next twenty years.
