A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED FINANCING FOR THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO 2000 PUBLIC SAFETY AND PARKING IMPROVEMENTS BY THE ISSUANCE BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY FINANCING AUTHORITY OF ITS 2000 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT REVENUE BONDS (CITY OF SACRAMENTO 2000 PUBLIC SAFETY AND PARKING IMPROVEMENTS), AND WHETHER THERE ARE ANY SIGNIFICANT PUBLIC BENEFITS TO THE CITY FROM SUCH PROPOSED FINANCING.

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "City Council") of the City of Sacramento (the "City") is authorized by law to lease real property for public purposes of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to enter into an Amendment to Master Site Lease and a related Amendment to Master Project Lease with the Sacramento City Financing Authority (the "Authority") relating to the proposed financing for the City of the City of Sacramento 2000 Public Safety and Parking Improvements, as more particularly provided in the copies of such leases on file with the City Clerk of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Authority intends to issue and sell its 2000 Capital Improvement Revenue Bonds (City of Sacramento 2000 Public Safety and Parking Improvements) in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$75,000,000 (the "Bonds") to provide funds for the purpose of financing the City of Sacramento 2000 Public Safety and Parking Improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All of the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and the City Council so finds and determines.

Section 2. A public hearing is hereby called and will be held by the City Council on Tuesday, the 20th day of June, 2000, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., at the regular meeting place of the City Council, City Council Chambers, Sacramento City Hall, 915 I Street, Sacramento, California 95814, which public hearing will consider the proposed financing for the
