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1. Regional Transit Monthly Status Report

**DISCUSSION:** David Boggs, Sacramento Regional Transit Agency General Manager, presented a status report on the Light Rail project. He explained that the projected budget is \$166.3 million with projected revenue estimated at \$166.9 million.

Chairperson Robie requested that Mr. Boggs prepare an update regarding the Crystal Ice House Issue to be shared with Committee members. Mr. Boggs also agreed to return at the March 11, 1986 Committee meeting with a report on the Light Rail Double Track Work Plan.

**REPORT(S) BACK:** The next monthly Rt status report is scheduled for March 25, 1986.

**ACTION:** The Report was received and filed.

2. American River Parkway Plan

**DISCUSSION:** Toke Masuda, Princial Planner, gave a brief history of the Parkway Plan and explained the differences between the updated plan and the 1975 version. Chairperson Robie and Councilmember Shore expressed concern about the charging of fees at Discovery Park, due to the lack of neighborhood parks in the area.

**REPORT(S) BACK:** None

**ACTION:** The Committee moved to recommend to the City Council that they ratify the County's Negative Declaration and adopt the Resolution approving the City's 1985 American River Parkway Plan.


3. Requests from Committee Members
