

RESOLUTION No. 2119
RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

August 11, 1927.

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the cost and expenses of improving "L" Street, from a point 30 feet easterly from the center line of 39th Street to a point 355 feet easterly therefrom, in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2119; and

WHEREAS, the time fixed by the City Clerk was August 4, 1927, at 8:00 o'clock, P. M., for the hearing by this Council upon said assessment, and which said hearing was postponed to August 11, 1927, at 8:00 o'clock, P. M.; and

WHEREAS, an owner of property assessed for the cost of said improvement has filed an appeal with said Council, objecting to, and protesting against, said assessment; and

WHEREAS, said Council has heard the protest and objection made against said assessment, and has taken evidence thereon at this hearing, and is now fully advised in the premises; and is satisfied with the correctness of said assessment and Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the protest against the said Assessment, Diagram and Engineer's Certificate be, and the same is, hereby overruled; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said Assessment, together with the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto be, and the same are, hereby confirmed and approved in all respects as filed.
