

ORDINANCE NO. 82-026

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SACRAMENTO CITY CODE SECTION 9.601 RELATING TO MEMBERSHIP ON THE PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS FOR PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PERSONS APPEALS BOARD, AND DECLARING SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1

Section 9.601 of the Sacramento City Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9.601 Membership.

The board shall consist of five members who shall be appointed as follows:

(a) Two members shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council;

(b) Two members shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento;

(c) One member shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County and the Mayor with the approval of the City Council;

(d) One member appointed pursuant to subsection (a) and one member appointed pursuant to subsection (b) shall be physically handicapped persons;

(e) One member appointed pursuant to subsection (a) and one member appointed pursuant to subsection (b) shall be experienced in construction;

(f) The one member appointed pursuant to subsection (c) shall be a public member;

(g) The Board of Supervisors of the County may appoint an alternate to the member appointed under subsection (c) of this section;

(h) The term of office of each member shall be three years, except for the term of office of the members first appointed, which shall be determined as follows:

(1) At the first meeting of the board, the members first appointed, except the member appointed pursuant to subsection (c), shall draw lots to determine their individual terms. Based upon the results of the lots drawn, the members first appointed shall have terms as provided in paragraphs (2), (3) and (4) of this subsection.

(2) One member appointed pursuant to subsection (a) and one member appointed pursuant to subsection (b) shall have an initial term of one year.

(3) One member appointed pursuant to subsection (a) and one member appointed pursuant to subsection (b) shall have an initial term of two years.

(4) The member appointed pursuant to subsection (c) shall have an initial term of three years.

SECTION 2 Emergency.

This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure, to take effect immediately, the reason being to permit immediate appointment of an alternate to the jointly-appointed member of the board.
