

RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$120,000 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A INTERPRETIVE WALKING TRAIL IN THE NORTH LAGUNA WILDLIFE AREA, ESTABLISH A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT (CIP#: LW91) AND APPROPRIATE \$30,000 FROM THE NORTH LAGUNA CREEK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FOR THE REQUIRED MATCH


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

The City Council hereby:

1. Accepts a grant from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation Recreational Trails Program in the amount of \$120,000;
2. Establishes a Capital Improvement Program Project for the development of an interpretive walking trail in the North Laguna Wildlife Area CIP (PN: LW91), and
3. Appropriates \$30,000 from the North Laguna Creek Assessment District (Fund 652) for the required match to be used for reconstruction and repair only.
