RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

WHEREAS, ROBERT D. LIVINGSTON and JEAN LIVINGSTON

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain  
RIGHT-OF-WAY Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the  
following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento,  
State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South line of Lot 16, as shown on the  
official "Amended Plat of a Tract of Land Comprising Lots 14, 15 and 16 of  
the Wiseman and Wulff Sutterville Heights Tract", recorded in the office  
of the County Recorder of Sacramento County on December 5, 1906, in Book  
7 of Maps, Map No. 35, located South 74° 19' 50" East 145.62 feet from  
the Southwest corner of said Lot 16, said Southwest corner being located  
on the center line of Mead Avenue a 40 foot Street; thence from said point  
of beginning North 11° 29' 20" East 64.85 feet, thence South 74° 19' 50"  
East 125 feet to a point in the center line of Francis Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

That the said RIGHT-OF-WAY Deed be, and the same is,  
hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy  
hereof to the said RIGHT-OF-WAY Deed, and record same in the  
office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
