ESTABLISHMENT OF OFFICE OF EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN CONSTRUCTION AND COMMISSION ON EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN CONSTRUCTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE
CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1: The Office of Equal Opportunity in Construction (OEOC) within the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (Agency) is hereby created effective January 1, 1993. The stated purpose of the OEOC is to provide:

- a) a coordinated mechanism to increase the number of women and minorities employed in federally and locally funded construction projects;
- b) a procedure to monitor records of construction firms for hiring in compliance with Executive Order 11246; and
- c) a forum for public entities to discuss these issues with construction-related firms, labor organizations, interested minority and women groups, and training, education and apprenticeship programs.

Section 2: A Commission on Equal Opportunity in Construction is hereby established for a period not to exceed two years from appointment. Participants will be recruited by the Agency, to be interviewed by one member each from the City Council, County Board of Supervisors, and Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission, and appointed by the Board of Supervisors and City Council no later than January 30, 1993.

Section 3: The Executive Director or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Sacramento to receive an amount not to exceed \$37,478 to provide the OEOC services to the City.

Section 4: The Executive Director is authorized to allocate a total of \$24,986 in Agency funds to provide the Agency's portion of financial support for OEOC operations.

Section 5: The Agency budget is hereby amended in accordance with the foregoing.
