The Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at the hour of 4:25 o'clock p. m., Mayor McKinney presiding and roll call was answered as follows:

ABSENT: Councilman Murphy.

Executed copies of the call of the meeting issued by the Mayor and presented by the City Clerk, were ordered filed.

The call stated the purpose of the meeting to be that of meeting with the Redevelopment Agency to receive the Master Plan Study for the proposed development of the Old Sacramento Area and Riverfront (Embarcadero) Park, as prepared by Candeub, Fleissig and Associates and to present such other matters as may regularly come before said body or be presented by the City Manager.
