

Resolution of Award No. 2552

2552

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 30th day of August 1946, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned; and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To J. R. REEVES

at the prices specified in his proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of 52nd Street from the southerly line of 9th Avenue to the northerly line of 11th Avenue, and the proposed 11th Avenue from the westerly line of Lot 83 to the easterly line thereof, all in Ellwood Tract, (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder),

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2552, passed and adopted by said City Council on July 19th 1946, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the Sacramento Union a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
