SUBJECT: GRANT APPLICATION - REPAIRS TO POLICE PATROL BOAT

SUMMARY

The Sacramento Police Department is requesting authorization for the City Manager to execute a grant agreement, with the California Department of Boating and Waterways. Under this grant, the City would be reimbursed by the State of California for up to \$2,000.00 in costs for approved repairs to the police patrol boat.

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance committee approve the attached resolution required by the California Department of Boating and Waterways and forward it to the City Council for consideration.

BACKGROUND

Enforcement and patrol of the waterways of the Sacramento and American Rivers within the limits of the City of Sacramento is the responsibility of the Sacramento Police Department. The Department's Boat Patrol operates two patrol boats in this assignment, a 1976 Enterprise and a 1982 Sea Ray.

Due to the extensive use these vessels endure, the older 19 foot Enterprise is in need of significant repairs. Both the steering and throttle control require replacement to ensure its continued safe operation. Additionally, there are several deep gouges in the boat's hull below the water line. This damage must be repaired soon to avoid further damage due to water intrusion in the hull material.

The California Department of Boating and Waterways is willing to grant funds for these repairs up to a limit of \$2,000.00, and a copy of the required agreement and resolution are attached. All repairs under this agreement must be completed by August 31, 1989, and all requests for payment of grant funds must be submitted by December 31, 1989.

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FINANCIAL DATA

The total grant amount for this project is \$2,000.00. The Department's budget will be augmented by \$2,000.00 to pay for the costs of the repairs to the Patrol Boat. The City's General Fund will be reimbursed for the costs of the repairs by grant funds from State of California.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

Application for available grant funds to augment City revenues and services is consistent with past practice.

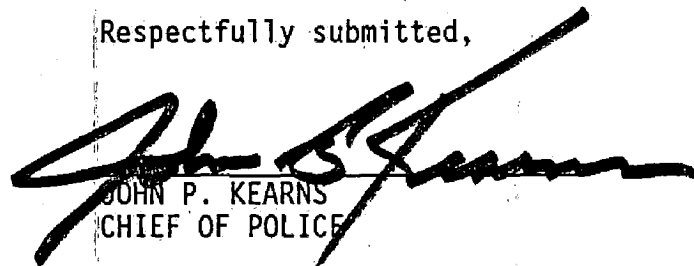

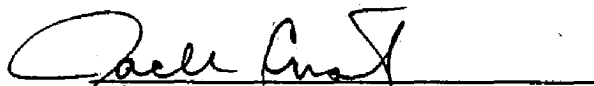
