Subject: Approval of a Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with the State of California and Resolution Authorizing City Manager to Execute the Agreement on Behalf of the City

SUMMARY

The resolution that the City passed for the California Department of Transportation to maintain City owned traffic signals on 12th Avenue at Franklin Boulevard and at 33rd Street expired on July 1, 1980.

It is recommended that the current maintenance procedure be continued and that the attached traffic signal maintenance agreement be approved and the attached resolution be passed authorizing the City Manager to Execute this Agreement on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND

In 1978 the State of California installed new traffic signals at Route 99 and 12th Avenue and at Franklin Boulevard and 12th Avenue. Later, the City installed traffic signals at 33rd Street and 12th Avenue.

These signalized intersections utilize Type 170 controllers which contain solid state electronics including microprocessors. The master controller is located at Route 99 with interconnect cables to Franklin Boulevard and to 33rd Street.

Inasmuch as the State has capable technicians to maintain this type of controller and since the master controller is located on a State highway, it is recommended that the State also maintain the traffic signals at Franklin Boulevard and at 33rd Street which are interconnected to the master controller. The State maintenance should be in effect until City forces are familiar with the maintenance of this type of controller which is expected to be approximately 10 months.

FINANCIAL

The annual maintenance cost of the traffic signals systems on 12th Avenue at Franklin Boulevard and at 33rd Street is estimated to be \$2500. That amount has been budgeted in the 1980-1981 Facility Maintenance Department Signal Activity 2705 fund.
