Subject: Report on Bids for GUTTER DRAIN REPLACEMENT DOWNTOWN

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer recommends that this report be filed pending recommendation of bid award at a later date.

BACKGROUND:

On October 12, 1982 the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Gutter Drain Replacement Downtown and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on November 2, 1982. The bids received are as follows:

The engineer's estimate for this project was \$109,489.00. Since the low bid is 9.32% above the engineer's estimate, an additional analysis of the project and the bids is necessary before a valid recommendation can be made.
