**SUBJECT: DEL PASO ROAD 24" WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN PROJECT (ZG66): AWARD
CONTRACT TO CON-STAR FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$431,495**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

The Del Paso Road 24" Water Transmission Main Project is located in Council District 1. See attached location map.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council accept the low bid from Con-Star for an amount not to exceed \$431,495 and award the contract.

SUMMARY

Bids were received from 12 contractors and opened by the City Clerk on May 5, 1999. The low bidder was Con-Star with a bid of \$431,495. Con-Star met the emerging and small business enterprise (ESBE) goals. It is therefore proposed to award the contract to Con-Star for \$431,495.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION

BACKGROUND

- Future development of North Natomas requires construction of water transmission mains for water supply.
- The design of the 24-inch transmission main along Del Paso Road allows for future growth within the City limits as shown in the City's Water Master Plan.
- The project is located along Del Paso Road from Truxel Road to East Commerce Way, approximately 3,700 linear feet.
- Bids were received from twelve contractors as follows:

- The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$470,000.
- The estimated completion date is September 1999.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The total project cost including design, construction, inspection and contingency is \$570,000 based on the bid of \$431,495. As of May 7, 1999, the unobligated balance available for this project (413-500-ZG66-4820) is \$719,224, which is sufficient for award.

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS

This project included participation goals of 20% for emerging and small business enterprises as required by Ordinance 99-007 and Resolution 99-055, relating to ESBE participation goals and policies, adopted by the City Council on February 9, 1999. The responsive low bidder, Con-Star, exceeded the ESBE goals with a participation level of 100%.

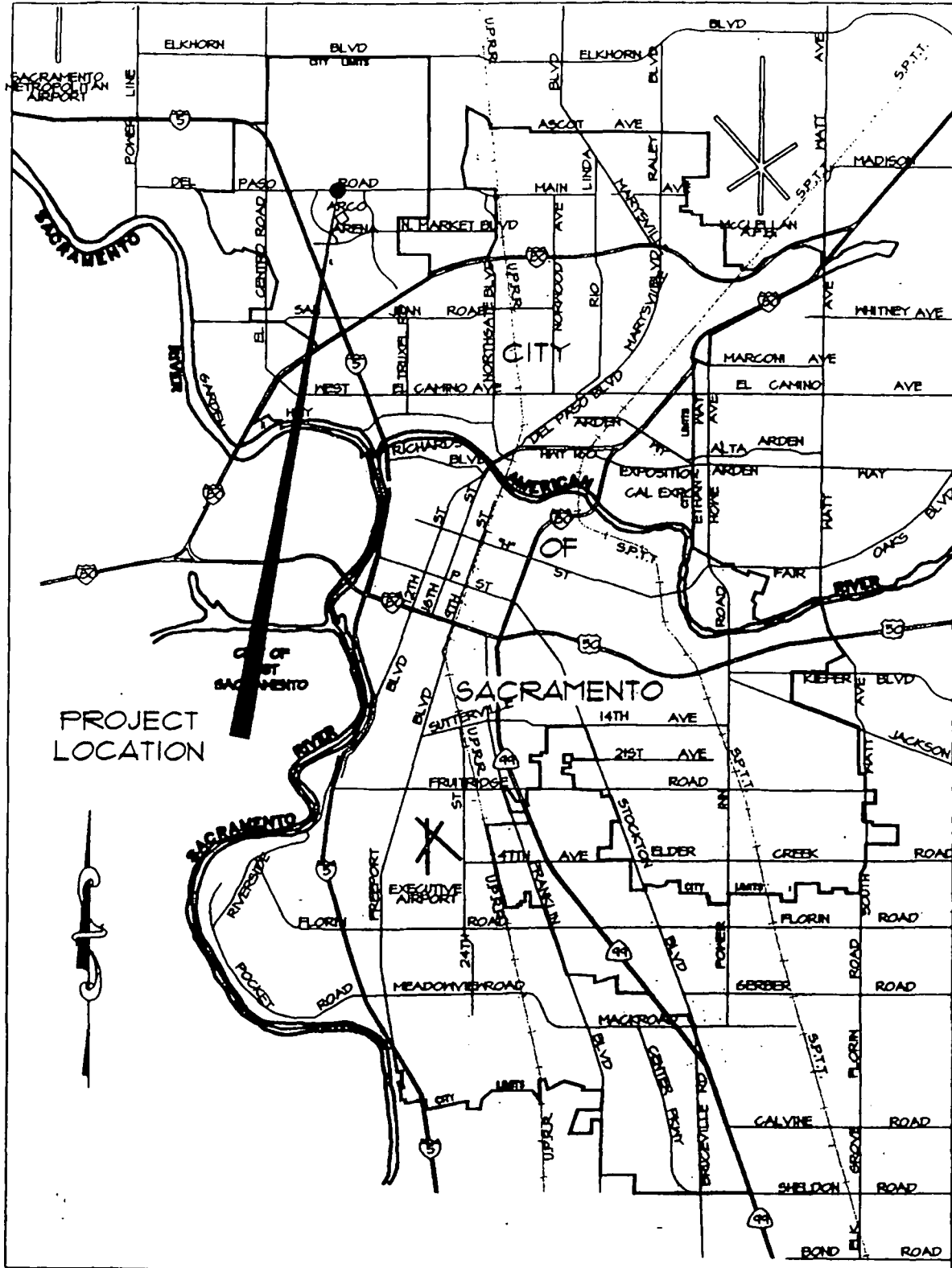
