RE: STREET VENDOR'S ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

Honorable Members in Session:

The Law and Legislation Committee recommends that the attached amendment to the Street Vendor Ordinance be adopted. The amendment adds a sentence at the end of City Code Section 7.52 and increases the area of the central business district by three and one-half blocks. The attached map further identifies the area.

The amendment would allow a street vendor's permit to be issued within the three and one-half block area, subject to compliance with all the terms and conditions of the street vendor's ordinance. There is a hotdog stand presently operating in the area near State Office Buildings 8 and 9.

ORDINANCE NO. 4415 FOURTH SERIES

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.52 OF
THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING
TO STREET VENDORS AND THE DEFINITION
OF THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 7.52 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7.52 Description of Central Business District.

As used in this article, the "Central Business District" shall mean all that area in the City of Sacramento bounded by the Sacramento River on the west, by the center of the blocks between 21st Street and 22nd Street on the east, by the alley between G Street and H Street on the north, and by the alley between N Street and O Street on the south, excluding therefrom the Old Sacramento Business District as defined in Section 7.56. The "Central Business District" also includes the blocks bounded by 6th and 8th Streets, and O and P Streets, and shall further include the block bounded by 7th and 8th Streets, and O and P Streets, and the south one-half of the block bounded by 7th and 8th Streets, and N and O Streets in the City of Sacramento.

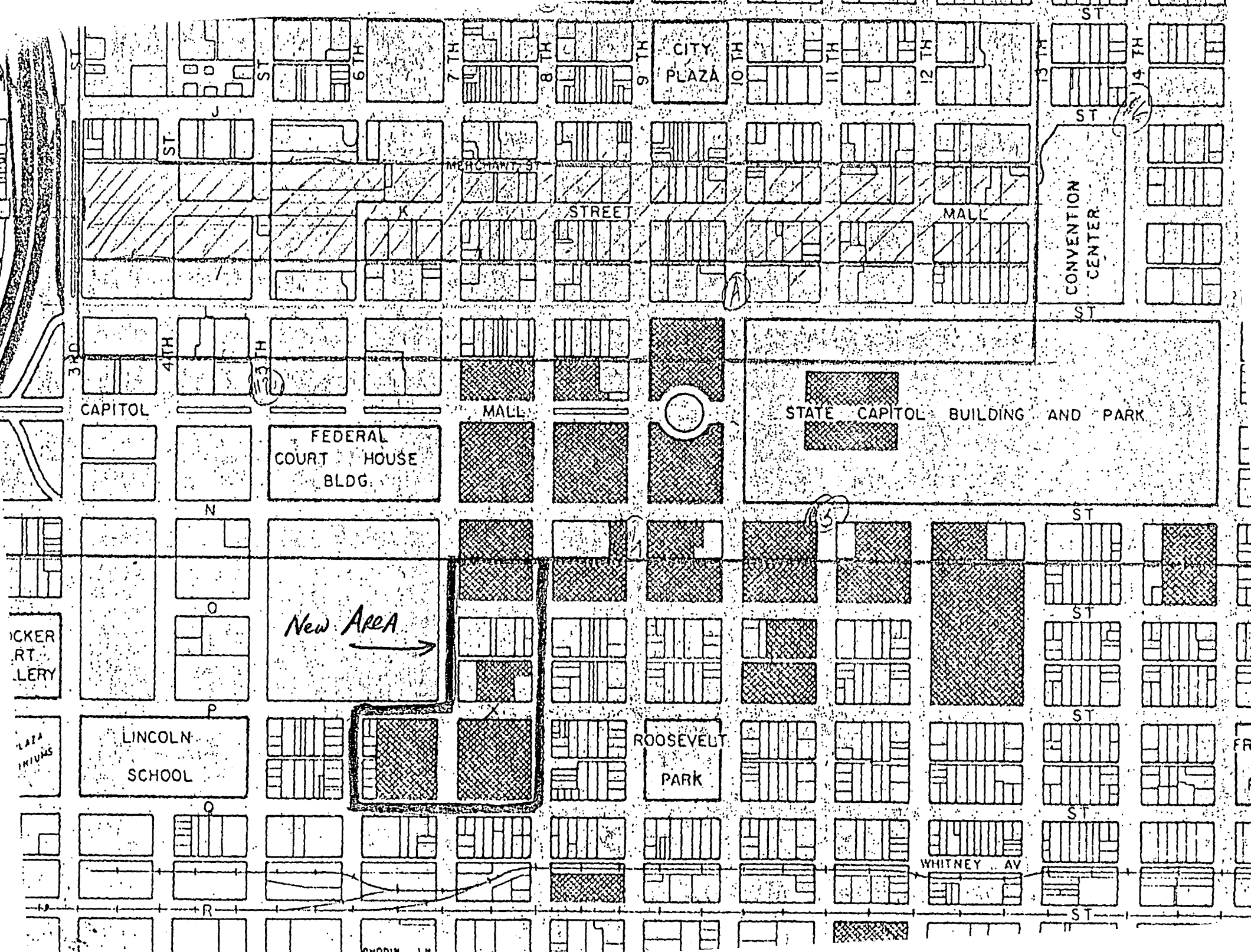

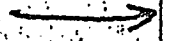
