## **Description/Analysis**

**Issue Detail:** This presentation will provide Water Committee (Committee) members with an overview of the City's potable water supply portfolio and what adaptation measures are being considered with increasing population, water use trends, and the state of the supply infrastructure. A focus on the groundwater portion of the City's supply portfolio is included and future presentations on other aspects of the City's water supply to complement the groundwater discussion will be developed. This presentation includes:

- Water Supply System Overview
- Timeline for developing new supply
- The role of groundwater today and strategic direction tomorrow
- Local groundwater governance and availability of resources
- Concepts for conjunctive management for surface water and groundwater to enhance water security.
- Infrastructure conditions and groundwater quality.
