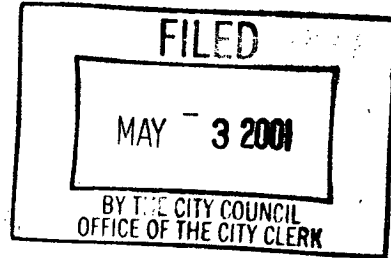

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID, AND CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARD TO M & M ELECTRIC FOR THE 15th AND E STREETS TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION PROJECT (PN:SM02)

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

The 15th and E Streets Traffic Signal Installation Project is located in Council District No. 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that City Council:

- Approve plans and specifications;
- Accept low bid of M & M Electric in the amount of \$139,880;
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the 15th and E Streets Traffic Signal Installation Project (PN:SM02)

SUMMARY:

This project involves installation of a traffic signal at 15th and E Streets including the installation of curb ramps at the corners. In addition, this project involves some upgrades requested by the Department of Utilities. Some of the work includes relocating and adding drain inlets and modification to an existing manhole located at the project intersection.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The project was authorized in the 1999/2000 Capital Improvement Program.
- The construction estimate was \$139,880.
- Bids were received and opened on March 7, 2001 and contract award to M & M Electric is recommended.

Staff's estimated construction cost was \$202,000. On March 7, 2001 the following bids were received:

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3.

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ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at www.cityofsacramento.org/bids.
