

RESOLUTION No. 87

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, by an election held under the Municipal Court Law of 1925, a Municipal Court was established in the City of Sacramento which consolidated therein the Police Court, and

WHEREAS, the attaches of said Police Court were blanketed in as officers of the Municipal Court, and

WHEREAS, by such operation, no person so blanketed in shall lose any of the benefits and privileges which attached to him by virtue of his office or position in the Police Court, and

WHEREAS, by virtue of their offices and positions in the Police Court, John R. Strachan, Nelson King, Clara F. Cochran, Fred L. Freitas, Dorothy Hosmann, and Harry F. Stober were members of the Sacramento City Employees' Retirement System, and

WHEREAS, there may be a question of their status unless it is confirmed by this Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That John R. Strachan, Nelson King, Clara F. Cochran, Fred L. Freitas, Dorothy Hosmann, and Harry F. Stober remain as, and are, members of said system with all the rights and privileges held by them before they became attaches of the Municipal Court of the City of Sacramento.
