



**SUBJECT: FUNDING FOR THE DOWNTOWN/NATOMAS/AIRPORT LRT ROUTE REFINEMENT  
AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT**

**SUMMARY**

This report requests the appropriation of \$100,000 from the General Fund Contingency as the City's share of the funding for Systems Planning/Study Task 11: Downtown/Natomas/Airport LRT Route Refinement Report and EIR. This report was heard by the Budget and Finance Committee on this same date.

**BACKGROUND**

At their meeting on February 27, 1989, the Regional Transit Board of Directors unanimously approved the "Financing Agreement with the City and County of Sacramento to Fully Fund Systems Planning/Study Task 11: Downtown/Natomas/Airport LRT Route Refinement Report and EIR". This agreement must be approved by the City Council and the Board of Supervisors prior to the Regional Transit Board's award of the System Planning Contract scheduled for March 27, 1989 in order for the contract to include the Task 11 work.

Task 11 calls for the study of two light rail routes between the downtown area and the Sacramento Metropolitan Airport. The consultant will prepare a report on these routes in preliminary, draft, and final forms as well as an Environmental Impact Report in draft and final forms. The EIR is to include information provided in related Systems Planning Study tasks. The consultant will also provide executive summaries for both the Route Refinement Report and the EIR.

Task 11 will enable the City and the County to assess the benefits of alternate routes in providing service to the Sacramento Metropolitan Airport, Sports Complex, and future residential areas in North Natomas. In addition, this task will enable the City and County to provide alternatives to the current proposal to use the I-5 Scenic Corridor as a possible alignment. The future cost of any extension will be shared by property owners along the adopted route.

**FINANCIAL**

The City's share of the cost is \$100,000. The County also has agreed to pay \$100,000. It is proposed that a new CIP project be established for this task and that funding for this agreement be from the General Fund Contingency Reserve. The current balance of the General Fund Contingency Reserve as of March 15, 1989, is \$635,500.




