Formal Investigations

Formal complaints are assigned to an Internal Affairs Division (IAD) investigator. If the allegation is in fact true, there would be a violation of policy and therefore potential discipline could be imposed. The race of the complainant and officer will be shared.

SCPRC Ordinance, Section 2.40.030 of Sacramento City Code:

2.110.030.B. The commission shall review quarterly reports prepared by OPSA consistent with CA Penal Code section 832.7(c), relating to the number, kind, and status of all citizen complaints filed against police department personnel, to determine whether there are patterns of misconduct that necessitate revisions to any police policy, practice, or procedure.

Informal Investigations

Informal complaints were handled at a lower level with only a preliminary investigation needed to determine either there was no violation of policy, or even if the allegation was true it would not violate a policy. The race of the complaint, not the officer will be shared.
