

RESOLUTION No. 215

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

September 5th, 1929

RESOLUTION DIRECTING AND AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR AND CONTROLLER OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO TO AUDIT AND PASS FOR PAYMENT AN APPROPRIATION OF \$25,000.00 TO THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE TO MEET THE DEFICIENCY IN THE PURCHASE PRICE OF A FEDERAL BUILDING SITE IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the sum of \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Sacramento, payable to the Chamber of Commerce, to be used to meet the deficiency in the purchase price of the site for a Federal Building, selected by the United States Government and to be constructed in the City of Sacramento.

The Federal Government having appropriated the sum of \$250,000 for the said site and interested citizens having offered and agreed to raise the sum of \$22,500.00 additionally, and the total purchase price of the site so selected being the sum of \$297,500.00, the said Chamber of Commerce of the City of Sacramento is hereby authorized to pay to the proper parties the said sum of \$25,000.00 hereby appropriated upon the conveyance to the United States of the title to the said site so selected, free and clear of all incumbrances, and the approval of said title by the proper legal representatives of the United States Government.

In the event that the purchase of the said site for said Federal Building is not consummated, then the moneys hereby appropriated is to be returned to the City of Sacramento by the Chamber of Commerce.
