

ORDINANCE NO. 1513, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 669, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 27, 1935, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF DANCING IN PLACES WHERE LIQUORS ARE SOLD; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 317, THIRD SERIES, PASSED OCTOBER 11, 1917, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY ADDING SUBDIVISION 8 TO SECTION 3 OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 669, Fourth Series, passed June 27, 1935, is hereby amended by adding Subdivision 8 to Section 3 of said Ordinance:

Subdivision 8: The area bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of 18th Street and Broadway; thence Northerly 140 feet; thence Easterly and parallel with Broadway to the center line of 20th Street; thence Southerly to the center line of Broadway; thence Easterly along the center line of Broadway to the center line of the extension of 20th Street from the south; thence Southerly a distance of 140 feet; thence Westerly and parallel with Broadway to the center line of 18th Street, and thence Northerly to the point of beginning.


SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within ten days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
