**SUBJECT: ORDINANCE RELATING TO ELECTION TO RECEIVE ALLOCATION  
FROM PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:** Council District 2

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that Council approve an ordinance which :

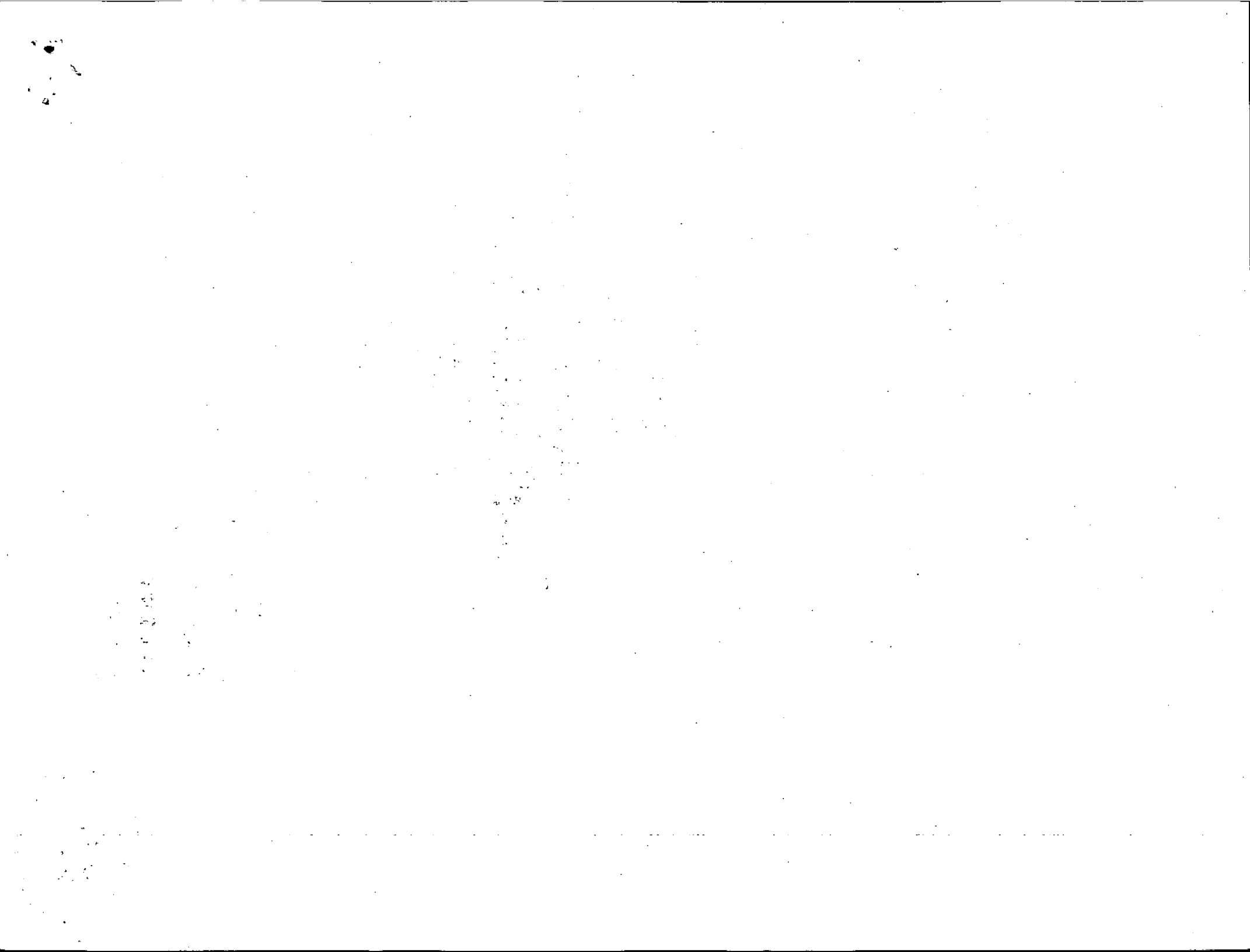
1. Authorizes the City of Sacramento to accept an allocation of pari-mutuel revenues from the California Exposition and State Fair (Cal Expo) satellite wagering facility and from live racing at Cal Expo; and
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute appropriate agreements with the County of Sacramento and the California State Fair to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

**SUMMARY:**

This report requests Council approval of an ordinance by which the City of Sacramento elects to accept an allocation of pari-mutuel wagers, and which authorizes the City Manager to execute appropriate agreements with the County of Sacramento and the California State Fair to implement the provisions of this ordinance.



It is estimated that revenues to the City and the County from pari-mutuel wagers will total approximately \$175,000 annually with these new funds to be used for funding mutually beneficial public projects.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The Cal Expo Board of Directors recently agreed to dedicate to the City and the County, 0.33 percent of pari-mutuel revenues, expected to be approximately \$175,000 annually, to be used for mutually beneficial public projects. Some of the proposed projects include sponsorship of the annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks show, stoplight upgrades and Cal Expo floodplain improvements. Receipt of these revenues is contingent upon the adoption by the City and the County of ordinances authorizing the City and the County to elect to receive these monies. The City and the County will cooperate to execute the designated projects, with the County acting in a fiduciary capacity with the responsibility of receiving, disbursing and accounting for the funds on behalf of the City the County and Cal Expo.
- The County of Sacramento agreed on June 25, 1998 to enact its own ordinance to accept the allocation from Cal Expo.
- Section 19610.4 of the California State Business and Professions Code grants the wagering facility the authority to distribute 0.33 percent of its revenues to the City or the County. This section also specifies that any such City or County electing to receive such a distribution may not, then, assess or collect any other fees, such as license fees, or business or excise taxes. However, the City and the County have reached an understanding with Cal Expo that the City and the County shall reserve the right to unilaterally terminate the allocation, should it be deemed proper for the City and/or the County to impose such taxes or fees as are prohibited by this section of the California State Business and Professions Code.

It is requested that Council adopt an ordinance by which the City of Sacramento agrees to accept the allocation of pari-mutuel wagers, and which grants the City Manager the authority to execute appropriate documents with the County of Sacramento and the California Exposition and State Fair to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The proposed agreement with Cal Expo will provide new revenue to the City and County of approximately \$175,000 annually to be received, disbursed and accounted for by the County, and to be used for mutually beneficial public projects.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

There are no environmental considerations associated with the actions recommended in this report. However, any future projects will be subject to CEQA review.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

The actions recommended in this report are consistent with City policy to form partnerships for the benefit of the public, and to provide services to the public in a fiscally responsible manner.

Section 1

Pursuant to the authority granted by California Business and Professions Code Section 19610.4, the City of Sacramento elects to accept an allocation of pari-mutuel wagers allocated pursuant to that section by resolution of the Board of Directors of the California Exposition and State Fair with respect to wagers placed at Cal Expo.

Section 2

The City Manager is authorized to execute appropriate implementation agreements with the County of Sacramento and the California Exposition and State Fair, to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

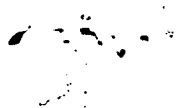

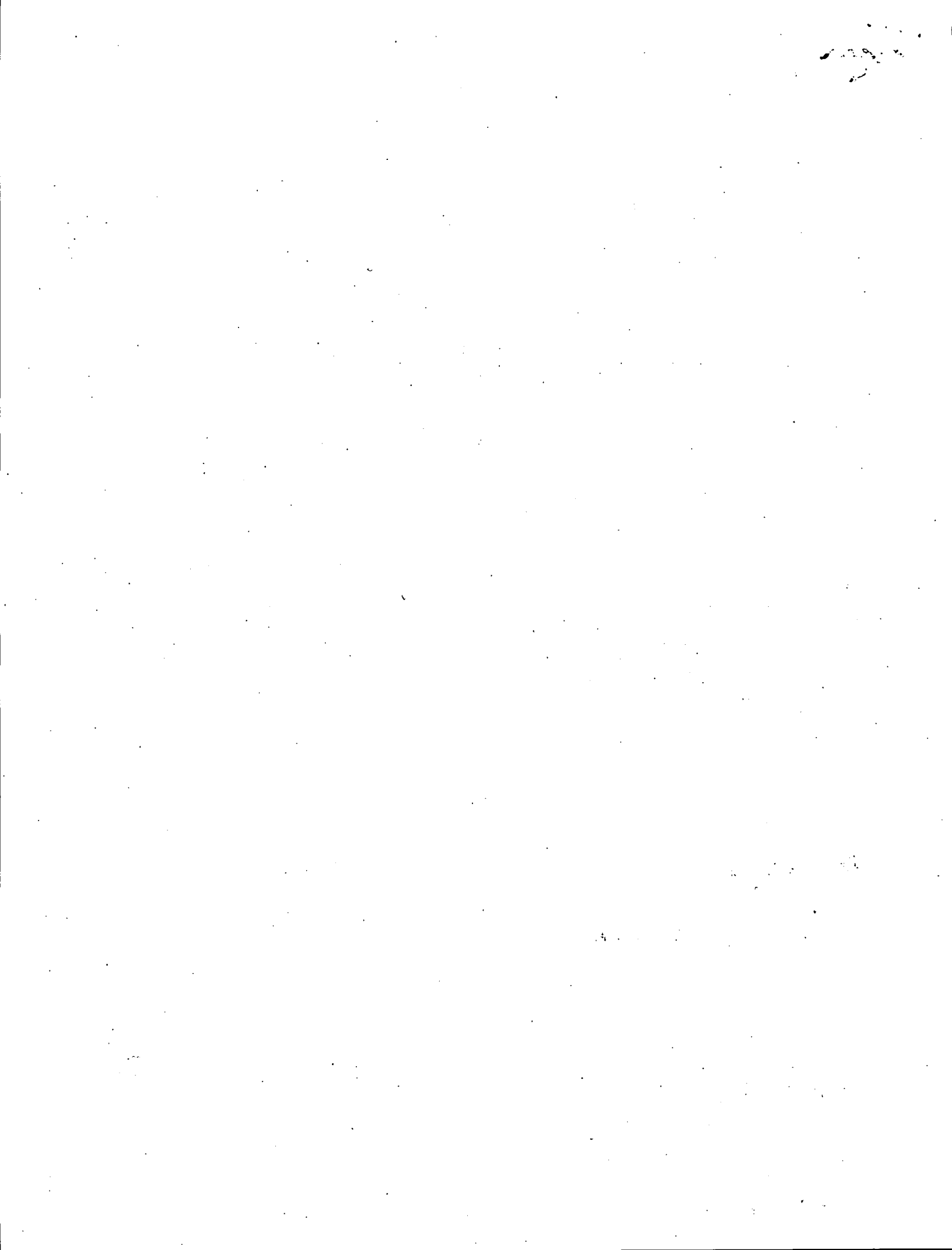

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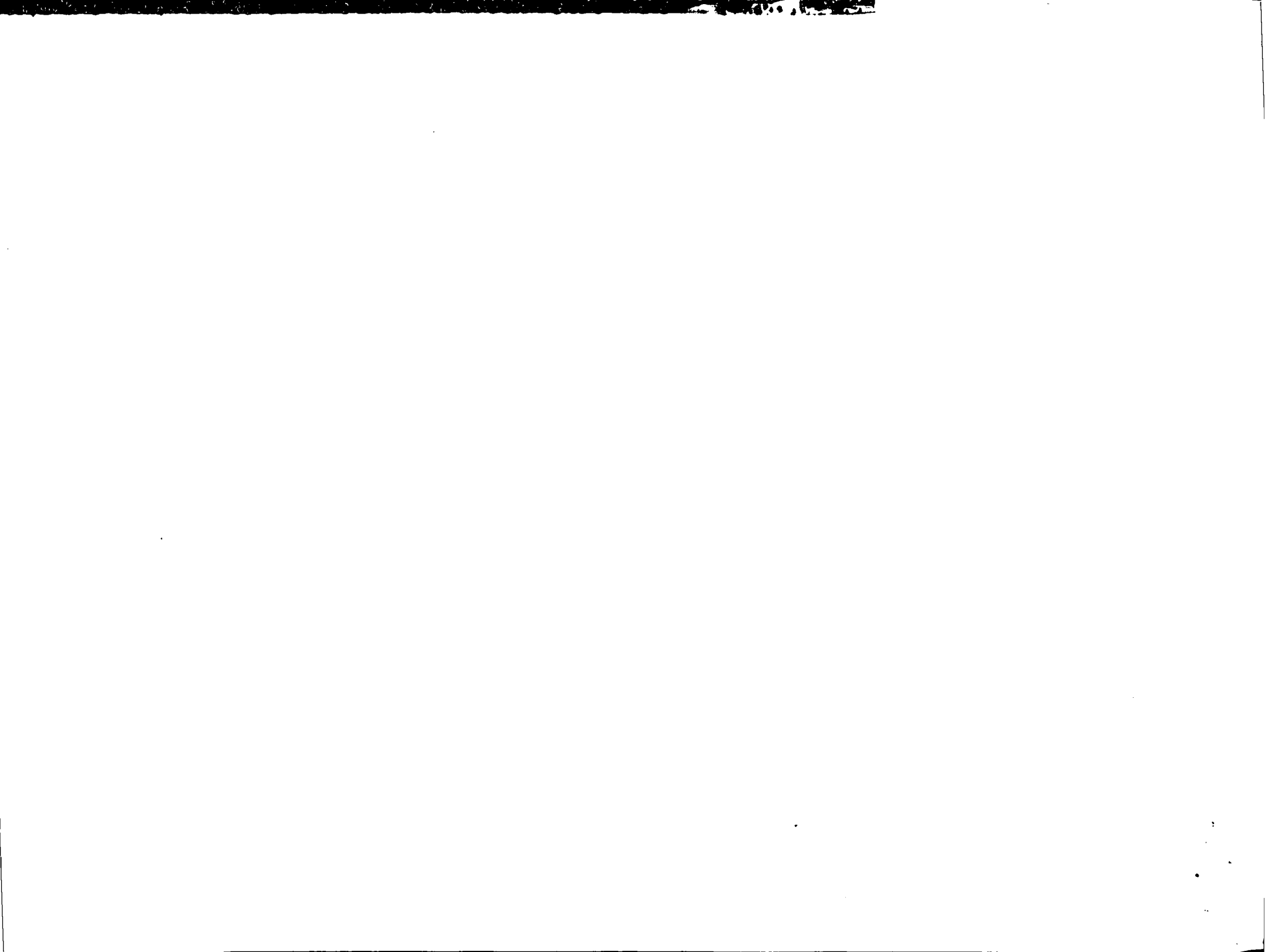
