SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Transfer of Major Street Construction Tax Funds from C.C. 2452, Overwidth Pavement Reimbursement, to the Fire Station No. 17 Frontage Improvements Project at Marysville Boulevard and Bell Avenue

SUMMARY:

It is proposed that \$100,000 be transferred from C.C. 2452, Overwidth Pavement Reimbursement, to the Fire Station No. 17 Frontage Improvement Project at Marysville Boulevard and Bell Avenue. The existing budget for the Fire Station project does not provide funds to construct the required street improvements at the site.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The 1981/82 budget includes \$200,000 of Major Street Construction funds in C.C. 2452, Overwidth Pavement Reimbursement. Because of the lack of current subdivision development, a balance of \$131,919.76 is available in the cost center as of March 4, 1982.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the City Council that the attached resolution be approved which transfers \$100,000 from C.C. 2452, Overwidth Pavement Reimbursement, to the Fire Station No. 17 Frontage Improvement project at Marysville Boulevard and Bell Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. The existing budget for Fire Station No. 17 does not provide funds to construct the required street improvements at the site.
2. The City Budget for Fiscal Year 1982-83 is hereby amended by transferring \$100,000 from Major Street Construction Tax funds, 2-09-2600-2452-4820 to the Fire Station No. 17 Frontage Improvement Project, 2-09-2600-2724-4820 for the purpose stated in paragraph 1 above.
