

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0075

Approving Applications and Agreements for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Grants for FY2020-2023 for the Youth Employment and Training Program

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento Department of Youth, Parks, & Community Enrichment has operated the Youth Employment and Training Program under the federal Job Training Partnership Act, funded by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), through the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA), since 1989. WIOA grants are to be used to provide the services for the youth to successfully complete high school and transition into employment. City Council approval is required to apply and accept the WIOA grants of up to \$400,000 annually for FY 2020-2023.
- B. The WIOA Youth Employment and Training Program is a year-round program that requires agencies to provide work experience linked to academic learning, secondary school completion services, leadership development opportunities for youth. The program provides adult mentors, comprehensive guidance and counseling, supportive services, and follow-up services for a minimum of twelve months after the youth leaves the program.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to submit a grant application for up to \$400,000 annually in WIOA funds for the next four years (FY 2020-2023) to SETA and the Sacramento Works Youth Committee on behalf of Sacramento Works, Inc. to fund the Youth Employment and Training Program.
- Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute the grant agreement with SETA if the agreement terms are consistent with the prior WIOA grants, and all related documents necessary to accept the grant funds.
- Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to establish a grant project and related revenue and expenditure budgets for the grant funds, contingent upon receipt of the annual grant award.
