RESOLUTION NO. 81-572

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

July 28, 1981

It is hereby noted that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Dr. John C. "Jack" Livingston on the 22nd day of July 1981, at the age of 62, in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Dr. Livingston joined the California State University, Sacramento faculty in 1954; was acting dean of the School of Arts and Sciences in 1971 and 1972; a founder of the statewide Academic Senate which he headed in 1970 and was head of the Academic Senate of the 19-campus state college system in 1965; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Livingston was honored in 1966 with the California State Colleges Distinguished Teachers Award; and

WHEREAS, in addition to Dr. Livingston's many contributions to the academic field, he was a civil rights advocate, served on the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Chancellor's Commission on Human Rights, and on the advisory panel of the Teacher's Bill of Rights;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which this meeting shall be called adjourned in respect to the memory of Dr. John C. Livingston.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to Ethel Livingston, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
