

ORDINANCE NO. 1505, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 669, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 27, 1935, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF DANCING IN PLACES WHERE LIQUORS ARE SOLD; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 317, THIRD SERIES, PASSED OCTOBER 11, 1917, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY ADDING SUBDIVISION 7 TO SECTION 3 OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 669, Fourth Series, passed June 27, 1935, is hereby amended by adding Subdivision 7 to Section 3 of said Ordinance:

Subdivision 7: The area bounded as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of Fruitridge Road and Stockton Boulevard; thence southerly along said center line of Stockton Boulevard to a point parallel with the south end of Lot 1 of Young's Subdivision; thence westerly from the said center line of Stockton Boulevard a distance of 162 feet to the southwesterly boundary line of Lot 1 of said Young's Subdivision; thence northerly along the westerly lot lines of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 to the center line of Fruitridge Road, and thence easterly along the center line of Fruitridge Road 162 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within ten days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
