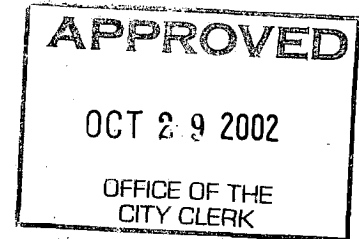

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

The Stockton Boulevard & 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue Street Lighting project is located in Council District 5. (See map - Attachment A).

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that City Council:

- Approve plans and specifications;
- Accept low bid of Shiloh Electric in the amount of \$208,250; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the Stockton Boulevard & 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue Street Lighting project (PN: SM74).

**SUMMARY:**

This project involves the installation of post-top street lighting in the area bounded by Stockton Boulevard, 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Lissetta Avenue.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The project was authorized by Council on September 25, 2001 as part of the citywide streetlight match program.

The construction estimate was \$160,000.

Bids were opened on Wednesday, August 14, 2002 and contract award to Shiloh Electric is recommended.

The following bids were received:

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The current total project budget is \$304,000. As of October 2, 2002, the unobligated balance is \$282,584, which is sufficient to award the contract in the amount of \$208,250.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Neighborhoods, Planning, and Development Services Department, Environmental Services Section, has determined that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 (b) and Section 15303 (d). A notice of Exemption has been filed with the County Recorder's Office.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3. Installation of the street lights is consistent with the City's Strategic Plans to enhance and preserve the neighborhoods.

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**ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:**

To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at [www.cityofsacramento.org/bids](http://www.cityofsacramento.org/bids). The recommended contractor includes certified ESBE participation of 66.39%.
