

RESOLUTION RESCINDING PROCEEDINGS NO. 2452

WHEREAS, Resolution of Preliminary Determination No. 2452, adopted by the City Council on June 20, 1941, providing for the improvement of street and right-of-ways in and adjacent to "MARSINO TRACT" and "MARSINO TRACT UNIT NO. 2" (as said subdivisions are shown on the official maps or plats thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California), which said improvement included the installation of an ornamental electric street lighting system; and

WHEREAS, it has been found that materials necessary for the erection of said street lighting system cannot be obtained on account of existing national defense priorities, and completion of the work cannot be assured within a reasonable time; and

WHEREAS, public interest and convenience require that the work, excluding the electroliers, be done without delay;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said Resolution of Preliminary Determination No. 2452, and all other proceedings and resolutions or orders taken thereunder or therefor, in the matter of said improvement, be, and the same are, hereby rescinded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Engineer be, and he is, hereby directed to present new proceedings for all of the said work, excepting the ornamental electric street lighting system.


