SUMMARY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit be granted to Mary Louise Podesta, whose address is 775 30th Avenue, San Francisco, California, for the purpose of installing a canvas canopy along the east side of the property at 1404 28th Street. Said Revocable Permit shall pass on to any successor in title of the adjoining property. This encroachment is described as follows:

A over-the-sidewalk canopy along the east side of the property at 1404 28th Street measuring 3'x 24'in length and at the height of 8'.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files the insurance certificates, required by the General Provisions, with the Risk Management and Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento.
