

RESOLUTION No. 334

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 14, 1936.

WHEREAS, a consolidated Regular and Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on the 5th day of November, 1935, pursuant to provisions of Article XXI of the City Charter of the City of Sacramento now in force, for the purpose of electing nine (9) members of the City Council of said city to serve for a term of two (2) years beginning January 1, 1936 and ending December 31, 1937; and

WHEREAS, the vote and returns of said election have this day been canvassed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento convening as a Canvassing Board and the results duly ascertained;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that the aggregate of the votes cast at said election for City Councilmen was 161462; that the total number of ballots cast by electors at said election was 20,449;

THAT THE TOTAL number of City Councilmen to be elected was nine (9);

THAT THE FOLLOWING CANDIDATES being all of the candidates at said election, receiving the number of votes set opposite their respective names, to wit:


