

RESOLUTION No. 206

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of



RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that the Central California Casket Company be granted a revocable permit to construct a spur track for the use of the American Fuel and Materials Company over and along the following described route:


at a point on existing spur track of the American Fuel and Materials Company by a switch cut in an said spur track at a point where the same would intersect the curb line if extended on the easterly side of Stockton Boulevard, and will run thence in a general southerly direction across said roadway or extension of Second Avenue to a point where the same enters the property line of the American Fuel and Materials Company; that the distance from the center line of the present spur track along said roadway or extension of Second Avenue to the property line of American Fuel and Materials Company by a direct line is approximately thirteen (13) feet.

FORWARDED PERMIT being in accordance with application and final point on record and filed on this date (Plan designated as proposed C. C. F. Co. Spur Track to American Fuel and Feed Co.) and under provisions of Section 287 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento and at no expense whatsoever to the said City of Sacramento.
