

RESOLUTION No. 173

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
April 12, 1940

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION OF PROPERTY FOR ACQUISITION BY CITY

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND AND DETERMINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the public interest and necessity require the acquisition by said City of certain real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, described as follows:

Beginning at the southwesterly corner of Lot 4 "The Flat-Iron Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California); which said point is further described as being located South $37^{\circ} 59.92'$ East, 255.71 feet from a monument marking the original center line intersection of 4th Avenue and Sacramento Boulevard, in the City of Sacramento; thence from the point of beginning North $18^{\circ} 34.32'$ East, 3.50 feet along the westerly line of said Lot 4, to a point; thence South $29^{\circ} 33.75'$ East, 35.08 feet, to a point on the southwesterly side of said Lot 4; thence North $34^{\circ} 06.87'$ West, 32.84 feet, to the point of beginning; and containing 46.00 square feet, more or less;

for the purpose of obtaining area necessary for the widening of Sacramento Boulevard between 4th Avenue and 5th Avenue; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to commence proceedings in Eminent Domain to acquire said property for said purpose.
