SUBJECT: CHILD CARE ORDINANCE UPDATE


Berkeley Planning Associates' report, THE NEXUS BETWEEN URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND THE NEED FOR CHILD CARE SERVICES: A REPORT TO THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, and the draft Staff Report for the Child Care Ordinance is being circulated to key managerial staff and will soon be sent to the members of the Government Child Care Ordinance Task Force. 
