

RESOLUTION No. 973

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

September 18, 1969


WHEREAS, in 1964, fifteen original members formed the Capital Cadets Drum and Baton Corps of Sacramento, in the hope that they might perform occasionally and, by so doing, entertain others as well as improving marching and baton techniques, and

WHEREAS, in the five years subsequent to that time, the Corps has grown to forty-one members, collected more than five-hundred individual and group awards, travelled thousands of miles, and performed to the advantage of numerous local activities, and


