SUBJECT: Western Pacific Railroad Operations and Issues (M-564)

LOCATION: Area bounded by Portola Way, 24th Street, and
Sutterville Road

On October 18th, the City Council discussed issues related to the operations of the Western Pacific Railroad Yard located on Sutterville Road. At that meeting, the Council requested the staff to organize meetings between the Sierra-Curtis Neighborhood Association representatives and the Western Pacific Railroad Company representatives. The intent was to have both parties, as well as the City Planning and City Attorney's office participate in discussions relative to issues and solutions related to the Western Pacific Railroad Yard operations. The Council requested this matter be brought back before them at their September 29th meeting.

To date, we have only been able to conduct one meeting with all representatives present; that being September 23rd. Although substantial discussion took place, no recommendations were confirmed. It was agreed that additional meetings would be necessary, and we have scheduled future sessions to continue discussion of this issue. We, therefore, request that the Council continue this matter at least until their meeting of October 27, 1981.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Council move to continue further discussion of the Western Pacific Railroad issues and operations until October 27, 1981.
