RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO APPROVING FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT  
FOR EXPENDITURE OF 1/4 CENT GAS TAX ALLO-  
CATED FOR STATE HIGHWAYS.

WHEREAS, the State of California, through its Department  
of Public Works, Division of Highways, has presented a First  
Supplemental memorandum of agreement in accordance with a pro-  
ject statement submitted by the City for expenditure of the  
1/4 cent gas tax for the 1937-1939 biennium allocated for  
State highways in the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard and read said agreement  
in full and is familiar with the contents thereof, and desires  
to approve the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of  
the City of Sacramento that said agreement for expenditure of  
1/4 cent gas tax allocated for State highways be and the same  
is hereby approved and the Mayor and City Clerk are directed  
to sign the same on behalf of said City.
