**SUBJECT:** APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND CONTRACT AWARD FOR 1997 HAZARD ELIMINATION SAFETY (HES) STREET NAME SIGN REPLACEMENT PROJECT (PN:RE01)

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Various Locations in all Council Districts.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Adopt the resolution appropriating \$20,000;
- Reject the bid of Chrisp Company as non-responsive;
- Accept the bid of McGuire Pacific Constructors in the amount of \$356,472; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the 1997 HES Street Name Sign Replacement project (PN:RE01)

**SUMMARY:**

This project will continue replacing street name signs with high reflective signs that will be more visible at night for motorists and emergency response vehicles.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- This project was authorized in the 1996/97 Capital Improvement Program and is funded primarily from a \$358,000 grant from the Hazard Elimination Safety Program (HES) of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA).
- This project was advertised and bids were received on April 16, 1997 and are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount	DBE Participation Goal 20%	Good Faith Effort
Chrisp Company	\$340,118	0.00%	No
McGuire Pacific Constructors	\$356,472	0.09%	Yes
Centerline Striping	\$391,425	0.00%	No

- The construction estimate was \$290,000. Higher than anticipated bids appear to be due to substantial increases in material costs (aluminum and reflective sheeting) that have occurred in the past two years.
- Chrisp Company did not meet the DBE goal and did not perform an acceptable Good Faith Effort.
- McGuire Pacific Constructors has made a good faith effort to meet the City's DBE goals and is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- Approval of the plans and specifications, fund appropriation and award to McGuire Pacific Constructors is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

- The project budget for Street Name Sign Replacement is \$358,000 (Fund 511, Federal Capital Grants).
- The unobligated fund balance, as of April 24, 1997, is \$342,612.
- Transfer of \$20,000 from the 94/95 Street Overlay Project (Fund 207, Transportation Sales Tax) is required to supplement the \$358,000 Federal grant and award the Project. The 94/95 Street Overlay project has been completed and has a remaining fund balance of \$330,638, as of April 30, 1997.

A Notice of Exemption was filed with the County Clerk on March 27, 1997.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at [www.sacto.org/bids](http://www.sacto.org/bids). Project notices were sent to 30 organizations involved in MBE/WBE recruitment.



\$34 million in major street repairs and a \$17 million backlog of pavement preventative maintenance have been identified. The Street Division is pursuing an active program of street overlays in an effort to reduce the maintenance backlog and preserve those streets still in good condition.
