
**WHEREAS**, this dedicated group of 50 men and women has successfully raised over \$500,000 for special “behind the scenes” needs of the Museum since its inception; and

**WHEREAS**, ASG responds beyond their financial contribution by providing dedicated volunteer support for many Museum activities; and


**WHEREAS**, thousands of Crocker Art Museum visitors benefit each year from the purchases made with ASG funds.






