

RESOLUTION No. 121

RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO FORMATION OF ASSESSMENT DISTRICT.

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento has been petitioned by owners of property lying along the line of North B Street, outside of the City Limits, to construct a sewer along North B Street, from 18th Street to a point opposite 5th Street, if produced northerly, and on 18th Street, from North B Street to alley between A and B Streets, and to form an assessment district to include the property represented on the petition, together with property lying within the City, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to grant said petition;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby consent to the formation of such assessment district, and the commencement of a proceeding under and pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled "An Act to provide for work upon streets, avenues, lanes, alleys, courts and places forming the exterior boundaries of any municipality, whether partly, or wholly, within or without said boundaries, and providing for the construction of sewers, drains and sidewalks thereon, and in connection therewith," approved April 21, 1911, and the several acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, and as tentatively shown on the plat of the proposed assessment district submitted by the City Manager; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento, State of California, be, and it is, hereby requested to consent to the formation of such assessment district, and the commencement of a proceeding under said Act, for the purpose of constructing a sewer along North B Street and 18th Street, as described aforesaid.
