

Resolution of Award No. 2116

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 2d day of **September**, 1926, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **J. W. TERRELL,**

at the prices specified in **his** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **9th Avenue, from the easterly line of Sacramento Boulevard to a point 122 feet easterly therefrom; right-of-way, owned by the City of Sacramento, along the westerly line of Lots 6, 7 and 8 of "Katherine Waldron Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California); and right-of-way, owned by the City of Sacramento, along the northerly line of Lot 7 of said "Katherine Waldron Tract".**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. **2116**, passed and adopted by said City Council on **July 29,** 1926, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement, **and of the district to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.**
