ORDINANCE NO. 984, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE-APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1943, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET AS AMENDED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1943, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1943, amounts sufficient to meet the expenditure requirements of the City, including salaries for offices and employments, as set forth therein, and based on the budget as amended for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1943, submitted by the City Manager and as determined and adopted by the City Council.

SECTION 2. This ordinance, in so far as it refers to salaries, supersedes, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1943, all salary ordinances now in force.

SECTION 3. This ordinance, being one appropriating money, is hereby made an emergency measure as provided by the Charter.
