

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-737

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

October 11, 2005

APPROVING THE LABOR AGREEMENT COVERING THE AUTOMOTIVE/EQUIPMENT MECHANICS UNIT

BACKGROUND

- A. Pursuant to the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act governing public sector collective bargaining, the City has met and conferred with the International Association of Machinists & Aerospace Workers (IAMAW) which is the recognized employee organization for employees in the Automotive/Equipment Mechanics Unit.
- B. The parties have reached an agreement on the terms and conditions of employment for employees in this Unit which are included in the Agreement dated September 2, 2005 which is attached as Exhibit A.
- C. The terms of the Agreement are consistent with the obligations of the City to bargain in good faith, are in line with the City's strategic goals and serve the interests of the City and the community by continuing positive labor relations.
- D. The general fund budget cost of the five-year Agreement is \$5,400,000 and the enterprise fund cost is \$4,800,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Labor Agreement covering the Automotive/Equipment Mechanics Unit is adopted effective October 11, 2005.
- Section 2. The Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Budget is amended to implement the labor costs included in the Agreement.


