



## Recognizing Emily Katz

WHEREAS, Emily Katz has voluntarily and enthusiastically chaired Sacramento's Campaign to End Childhood Hunger Committee for more than four years since its inception in October of 1993; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Katz was instrumental in connecting Sacramento's Campaign with the national effort of the same name, resulting in Sacramento's visibility as a national leader in child nutrition reform; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Katz initiated the first contact with KTXL FOX40 that eventually resulted in a three county public service campaign known as Tune In To Breakfast that encourages thousands of Sacramento area children to eat breakfast and use the school breakfast programs available to them; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Katz has, through her work at California Emergency Foodlink, provided thousands of pounds of donated fruit to Sacramento families through the City-sponsored Summer Food Service program; and

WHEREAS, Emily Katz has been a highly effective advocate, on behalf of childhood hunger issues, with local, state, and national policy makers, and program operators contributing to significant increases in the accessibility and utilization of federally-funded nutrition programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend Emily Katz for her dedication to ending hunger for children and their families in the Sacramento area by chairing Sacramento's Campaign to End Childhood Hunger.
