SUBJECT: Oak Park Street Lighting (PN:SA26/SA31) - Resolution Approving
Negative Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the Oak Park Street Lighting project would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On March 11, 1987 the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On March 13, 1987 Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

This project will install a street lighting system in the previously unlighted area of Oak Park, bounded approximately by Y Street, Stockton Boulevard, 12th Avenue and 40th Street. The project will be funded by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency with Community Development Block Grant funds.

The Environmental Coordinator recommends that the attached resolution be passed which will:


1. Determine that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment.


