

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-013

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 9, 2007

APPLICATION AND GRANT ASSURANCES FOR \$809,000 OF ANNUAL FEDERAL FUNDS FOR CALIFORNIA TASK FORCE SEVEN (CA TF-7), URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE (US&R) TEAM

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento Fire Department has been the sponsoring agency for CA TF-7, US&R team since the inception of the federal US&R program in the early 1990s. CA TF-7 has responded for emergency assistance to the bombing of the Federal Murrah building in Oklahoma City, the terrorist attack of the World Trade Center in New York, and to the Gulf Coast in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina.
- B. To apply the federal US&R funds of \$809,000, the City must submit the required application to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); the City must adopt a resolution granting signature authority for the City Manager to sign the Application for Federal Assistance.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to sign the Application for Federal Assistance and grant assurances to apply for annual funding of \$809,000 for CA TF-7, US&R team from FEMA.
